Nagpur Lodge Of MMM No. 22, Nagpur COVID 19 CHARITY PROJECTS

charity was done at the following centers :

Deen Dayal Thali: This organization supports the poor patients & families at Govt Med College Nagpur, by providing meals on a daily basis. The Lodge donated Rs.7700/- towards the same.

BBSKB Sanstha Nagpur: This voluntary organization has been catering the very



specific demands of the poor rag picker children of Sonagaon area. They have the complete data base of the children and try to provide them necessary aid whenever required. Rs.7000/- was donated towards their food during the lockdown.

SVAA Nagpur : Ex students of Saraswati Vidyalaya, Nagpur have been visiting the areas around the city and identifying pockets where aid is to be provided to the hutment dwellers where there is scarcity of supply. In accordance 15 households were handed over essential grocery packets, to last a week per hutment.

Lodge Cherian No 183, Bhopal

Most of the children are very poor whose parents are daily wage earners. They are in a very bad stage at present. The school management approached them for some help



in form of ration for them.

Lodge Independence No. 392 immediately got to work and collected donations from it's





members. Within 24 hours we arranged 18 kits of rations. Each kit costs Rs. 650/- containing various necessary kitchen needs. On 14th April W. Bro. Ajay Waikar, our WM and W. Bro. Sanjeev Kekatpure, our Chaplain went and handed over the items.
